MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

As we reflect on this year one word comes to mind: transformative. We have so much to celebrate, and we could not have done it without our strong network of clients, donors, volunteers, staff, and partners. 2019 marked the Rape Recovery Center's 45th anniversary. We celebrated this exciting milestone with a commemorative video made by the generous and talented Syna Harris, with contributions from many of the important individuals who helped grow the center in big and beautiful ways over the past four and a half decades.

This year was one of several exciting "firsts" for the center - including the launch of our new Entrenamiento de Asesoria, a 40 hour advocacy training that certifies new sexual assault counselors in the Spanish speaking community. We look forward to hosting future training's in partnership with the Utah Coalition Against Sexual Assault. This training precipitated the launch of our Spanish 24 hour crisis line. This new program ensures that Spanish-speaking survivors can access an advocate who is fluent in their language 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (previously Spanish language callers to our crisis line were served through a translation service).

We worked hard to expand our prevention services in 2019, hiring a fulltime Prevention Coordinator to join our growing Education and Outreach Team. A new grant was awarded through the Department of Justice, in partnership with the International Rescue Committee. This program, the Refugee and New American Men and Boys Ally Education Project, will allow us to grow our prevention services in new and exciting ways.

As we reflect on the past year, we are proud to share that over 14,000 lives were impacted by the services offered at the Rape Recover Center this year. We move into 2020 with a continued commitment to providing these essential services, and to growing our prevention efforts as we move toward our vision of a community free from sexual violence.

3,591 MOBILE ADVOCACY at Salt Lake County hospitals and clinics.


1,977 FOLLOW-UP CONTACTS following rape kit collection.




PREVENTION

We firmly believe that we can live in a community where everyone is safe and free from violence. Our prevention team works to make this dream a reality, ensuring that communities have the support they need to address the root causes of violence. In 2019, we focused on growing our long term prevention collaborations and strategic partnerships to ensure that all communities have access to the resources and information they need to take prevention into their homes and hearts.



- Through our Let's Get Consensual Bar Intervention curricula, we partnered with two local bars to teach intervention skills to their staff.
- For the first time in Rape Recovery Center history we received a competitive grant to create the Refugee and New American Men and Boys Ally Education Project a partnership with the International Rescue Committee.
- Utilizing our Qummunities Curricula we were able to provide two, 8-week LGBTQ+ focused healthy relationship cohorts.
- Statewide Partners in Prevention is a working group consisting of sexual assault services across the state; working through complex policy iniatiatives to set the standards for violence prevention in the state.
- Our School District Partnerships with Salt Lake School District and Granite School District has allowed us to work with schools and stakeholders to taylor prevention initiatives to local cultures.

PARTICIPANTS IN OUR SEXUAL VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM:

Increased non-violent problem solving skills

- More likely to ask someone for advice on how to handle a situation where they are angry
- More likely to listen to the other person's side of the story when they were angry at them
- More likely to ask the other person how they were feeling when they were angry at them

Increased Intervention and Help-Seeking Behaviors

- More likely to seek services for domestic and sexual violence.
- More likely to identify emotional and psychological abuse in addition to physical abuse as in need of intervention.
- More likely to accurately define and practice consent overall
- Bar staff reported a substantial increase in direct intervention in problematic behaviors in their establishments.

Decreased attitudes that promote sexual violence

- Youth identified being more empowered to define and utilize positive consent
- Parents identified being more empowered to intervene in problematic situations for their children and to teach them about positive consent more often
- More likely to agree with the statement "if me or someone I know is experiencing a problem like domestic violence, sexual violence, or bullying, I know at least one person I can trust and go to for help"




